Book selection guidelines

We will prioritize Christian books, book by Christian authors, classics, missionary biographies, and other books that may not be available at our public libraries. We aim to select books that kids are excited to read and contain excellent writing and storytelling.

While some books, specifically fantasy, may contain references magic, books selected will never portray witches or witchcraft positively. "Magic" on the other hand is sometimes employed by Christian authors as a representation of the supernatural and can be portrayed as a force for good. An example would be C.S. Lewis's "Deep Magic" in the Chronicles of Narnia.

Books will rightly portray Biblical truth. We will be especially picky about the wording in picture books. While some books might possibly have romantic elements (e.g. classics like Anne of Green Gables), we will not stock "teen romance" books, even Christian ones. "Young women of Jerusalem, I charge you, do not stir up or awaken love until the appropriate time." Song of Solomon 8:4 CSB
